

COVID-19 CONTROL PLAN

1. Although the state of Rhode Island allows “groups” of 15 in camp situations, Sandy Point Stables will have no more than 8 total (usually 6) per camp session.
2. Every Morning each camper will be have their temperature checked using a digital thermometer.
3. The parent or guardian dropping off the camper will be asked if the camper has been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for the virus. They will also be asked if the camper has exhibited any signs of illness that includes temperature, chills, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea. If the camper does have a temperature or the answer to any of the screening questions is yes, then the camper may not participate in camp.
4. Each camper must have their own mask and unless mounted, the mask must be worn at all times in the barn or in close contact outside.
5. Only 1 camper at a time will be allowed in the tack room.
6. Each camper will be given their own grooming/tack cleaning bucket with their name for use while at the barn. Each bucket will be cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day.
7. Several tack cleaning stations will be set-up so that appropriate social distancing can be maintained.
8. Several handwashing/hand sanitizing breaks will be taken during each day.
9. Door handles, cross tie snaps, light switches, etc. will be cleaned throughout the day.
